GABFEST. - This is a time each Friday morning for members to get together at the Hall for coffee and treats. ' If more funds are received, they are given to Treasurer of the Board. Blood pressures are checked on the 3^d Friday of the month by retired nurses.

POOL - Members who would like to play pool are invited to show up at 9:00 am each morning.

GAMES - Members wishing to play cards or etc. can come to Hall a little before 2:00 pm on Sunday and 7:00 pm on Monday and Thursday.
